I use the Canada's study abroad experienced, I'm going to make articles which everyone who are visiting Japan can enjoy life in Japan. (Seiya A)

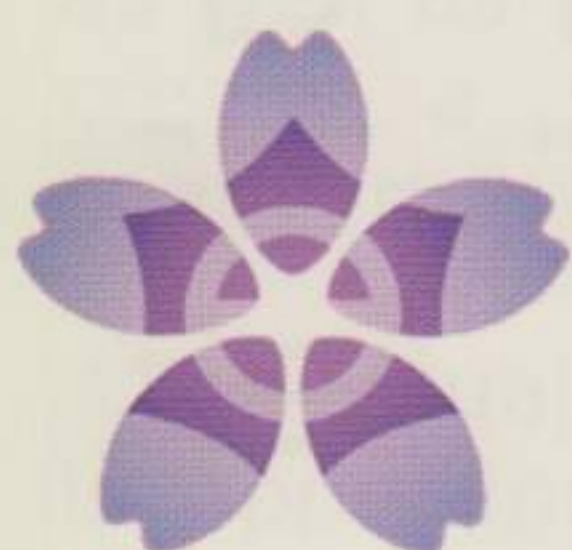
