2. The training on how to use the food supply: the volunteers from Red Cross Society will

show you how to distribute and cook the processed instant rice

3. The demonstration by the public institutions: The fire station and the police station will deliver a speech and perform a demonstration on the prevention of disaster.

4. The training to save the injured: The first brigade, police officers and affiliated organizations will cooperate with the local residents and perform a drill to save people trapped inside collapsed buildings. And many other trainings will also be held!!
