Tokyo International Communication Committee (TICC) is a organization established in 2003. Its main activities are:

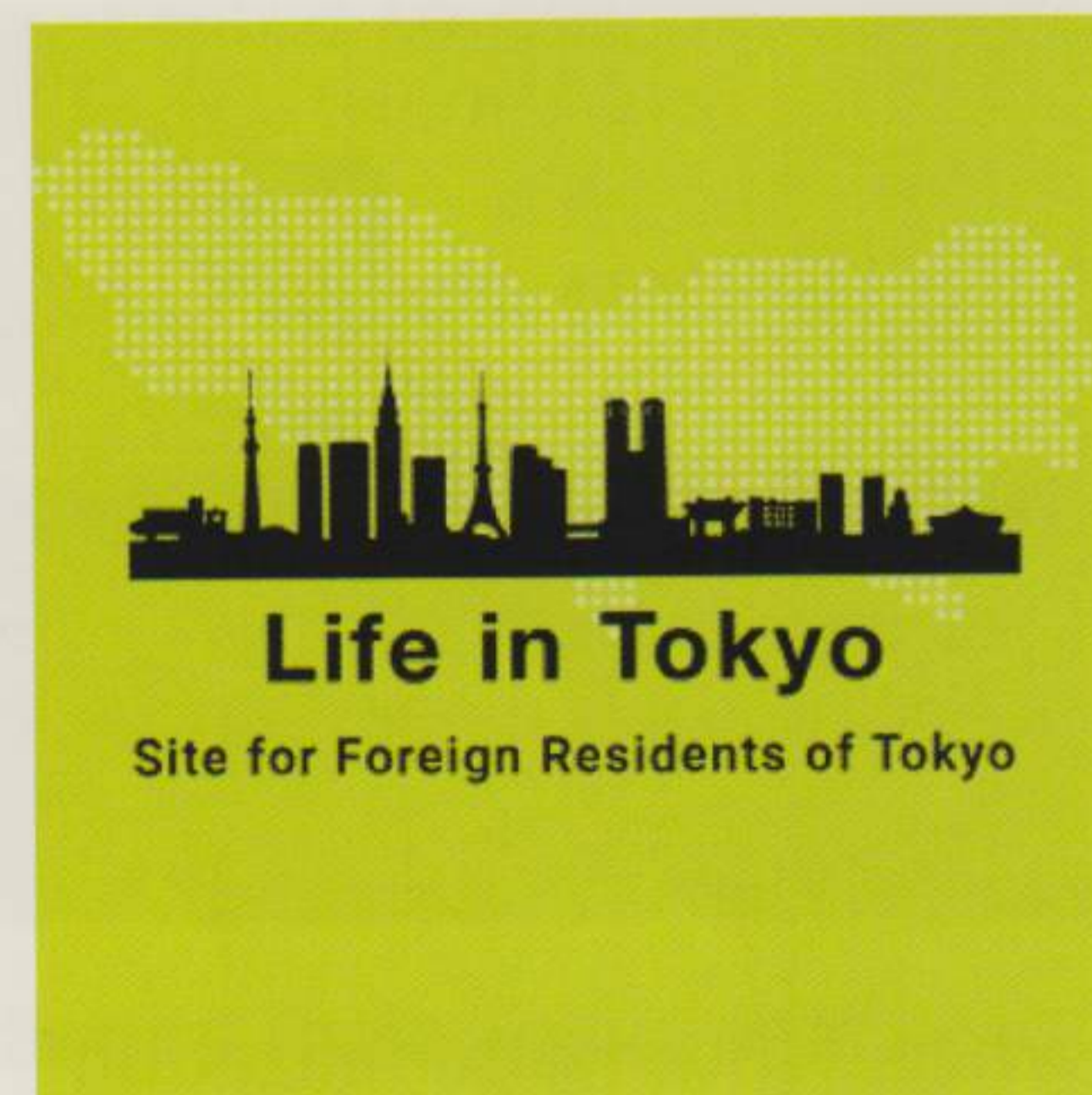
1. providing information of the official website for foreign residents
2. deepening connectivity with local international associations
3. hosting International Citizen's Forum in Tokyo to give more people awareness on cross-cultural relations.

In 2016, TICC designed a portal site to provide centralized access to all the information concerning multicultural coexistence, in accordance with Tokyo Guidelines for the Promotion of Intercultural Cohesion set by Tokyo Metropolitan Government in Feb. 2016.

It was challenging to build a website so that people can find the necessary information with little effort. TICC started hearings of first-hand experiences of members of local international associations, NPOs/NGOs and other organizations, as well as expats living in Japan. As a result, TICC decided to create a website that is foreign residents friendly and connecting them with the local communities.
